Your Excellency,

Amnesty International the impartial and highly respected organization for the protection of Human Rights has informed me of the situation of **Aser Mohamed** who was arrested at the age of 14 years on 12 January 2016. Following a period of enforced disappearance of 34 days a confession was produced under torture.

In October 2019 he was convicted of membership in the Muslim Brotherhood and of the participation in an attack on a hotel. An appeal has been lodged at the end of 2019, but the family has not received a fixed date of a new trial yet.

Together with Amnesty International and in consideration of his young age and the long period of detention I call on you to immediately and unconditionally release Aser Mohamed and to drop all charges against him. Pending his release the contact to the lawyer of his choice and to his family must be guaranteed.

Please induce an independent, impartial, thorough and effective investigation into the allegations of enforced disappearance and torture and bring any suspected perpetrator to justice, with due regard for the right to a fair trial.

Please protect in times of COVID-19 the health of all prisoners in Egypt.

Thank you for respecting the Human Rights of every citizen of the Arab Republic of Egypt.
