Dear Prime Minister,

Amnesty International the impartial and highly respected organization for the protection of human rights has informed us of the situation of **Abdul Aziz Muhamat** a recognized refugee from Sudan. Together with some other 800 refugees and asylum seekers he is being detained by the Australian Government under devastating circumstances on the island of Manus in New Guinea-Papua.

Abdul Aziz Muhamat is reporting from the prison to the outside world via his mobile phone. He is an engaged human rights activist and has become the target of various attacks of threats and intimidation.

We urge to ensure that he can continue his legitimate human rights activities free of threat and intimidation and to grant him the access to Australia

Asylum seekers and refugees are being denied their human right for a fair procedure of application for asylum according to the Geneva Convention on Refugees which both Australia and New Guinea-Papua have ratified.

We strongly demand from you, dear Prime Minister, to put an end to the practice of detaining asylum seekers and refugees outside Australia. All asylum seekers and refugees have the right to comprehensive asylum procedures leading to admission in Australia or another safe third country.

Thank you for respecting the Human Rights of every human being under the control of your country.
